A memorable highlight will always be his participation as one of Wyoming's lawyers in the United States Supreme Court appeal in *Wyoming v. United States*, an appeal that resulted in an unusual tie when one of the justices recused herself following oral argument. Dave has authored many articles on water rights subjects and has spoken on water rights and other subjects to lawyers and non-lawyers alike.

Long a strong supporter of providing legal services to the poor, Dave is a past member and chair of the board of directors of the Legal Aid Foundation of Colorado, Inc., a private not-for-profit corporation which develops funding for legal services programs in Colorado. Though long ago term-limited as a board member, he continues his annual fundraising efforts for the Foundation.
